How does Trident Funding LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does Trident Funding LLC collect my personal information? Definitions		
Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include companies owned by Boats Group 	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Trident Funding LLC does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you. 	
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. ■ Our joint marketing partners include other financial service companies. 	

California Residents Only: We will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by California law. California residents are provided a California notice for additional choices.

Vermont Residents Only: We automatically treat customers with a Vermont mailing address as having limited sharing with our affiliates as described on page one. If we share information under a joint marketing agreement, we will only disclose your name, contact information and information about your transactions and experiences with us.
